INDUCTION OF NEW MEMBERS

Lambda Alpha was organized in 1930 at Northwestern University. Our Society is an honorary professional organization whose members are chosen from the community at large. Selection is based on outstanding contributions in the field of land economics, either theoretical or applied.

With the establishment of the Simcoe Chapter in Toronto in 1967, Lambda Alpha expanded beyond the borders of the USA and became Lambda Alpha International. There are now 29 Chapters of Lambda Alpha: 19 in the United States and 3 in Canada, plus Chapters in England, Spain, India, Japan, Mexico, the United Arab Emirates and a growing collegiality worldwide.

Lambda Alpha International is designed to bring together persons of stature, accomplishment and responsibility who deal with the many different aspects of land economics – that is, the utilization of land resources to secure the physical, aesthetic, economic and social goals of the community.
